# TRANSBOUNDARY WATERS IN WIDER EUROPE

**Presenting UNECE's Second Assessment** 

Transboundary waters are a major source of income for millions of people and create security, environment, political and social-economic interdependencies.

The United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE) is pleased to present the recently published *Second Assessment of Transboundary Rivers, Lakes and Groundwaters* which is the most comprehensive, up-to-date overview of the status of transboundary waters in the European and Asian parts of UNECE region, covering more than 140 transboundary rivers, 25 transboundary lakes, about 200 transboundary groundwaters, 25 Ramsar Sites or other wetlands of transboundary importance.

Prepared under the UNECE Convention on the Protection and Use of Transboundary Watercourses and International Lakes, the Second Assessment illustrates the progress made in the pan-European region as well as the challenges ahead and the hot spots.


